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Eligibility and Preparation Policy:

- Couples are eligible to wed at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Urbana if at least one member of the couple is a current parishioner in good standing with the Catholic Church. Non- Parishioners may be considered eligible with the permission of the pastor. (Couples in these unique circumstances agree that additional charge, paperwork, and preparation may be required.
- At least one party must be Catholic, and both must be eligible for the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony in the Catholic Church according to local and canonical guidelines. Preparation for weddings in which one or both parties require a declaration of nullity (annulment) will not proceed until said declaration of nullity is pronounced and verified.
- Both parties must complete the marriage file and preparation program requirements of the Diocese
 of Peoria. Requirements must be completed no later than two weeks prior to the wedding date. If
 requirements are unfulfilled by this deadline, St. Patrick Catholic Church will not be responsible for
 any costs accrued for weddings that are unable to be performed due to failure to fulfill the marriage
 preparation program and requirements in this time frame.
- St. Patrick Catholic Church reserves the right to revoke wedding reservation due to fraud or
 misrepresentation, written or oral, on the part of the bride or groom during the preparation
 process. St Patrick Catholic Church will not be held responsible for any cost accrued for weddings
 that are unable to be performed due to such fraud or misrepresentation.
- St. Patrick Catholic Church reserves the right to postpone weddings at the discretion of the clergy due to pastoral concerns that arise during the marriage preparation. St. Patrick Catholic Church will not be responsible for any costs accrued for weddings that are postponed for reasons of pastoral concern.
- The church building is not reserved for a wedding until this application is approved by the pastor, and a priest or deacon has agreed to officiate the ceremony. ANY costs accrued prior to the completion of the above conditions are not the responsibility of St. Patrick Catholic Church.
- Weddings are generally not performed during Lent (mid-February through Easter), and are discouraged during Advent (December).
